1. Data Controller and Contact Information

This privacy policy applies to the processing of personal data by metasafety.org. The company has not started trading yet, but when it does, it will be registered as an *autoentreprise* in France.

I respect your privacy and am committed to protecting your personal data in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), and applicable French data protection laws.

2. Personal Data I Collect

I may collect and process the following categories of personal data that you provide to me directly:

- * Identity and Contact Data: Your name, email address, and telephone number.
- * Transaction and Billing Data: Billing address, payment details, and information related to your purchases. Please note that payment information is processed securely by my third-party payment service providers. I do not store your full payment card details on a server.
- * Communication Data: Any personal data you choose to share when you contact me via email, contact form, or other means.

3. How I Use Your Data and Legal Basis for Processing

I will only use your personal data when the law allows me to. The list below describes my purposes for processing, the data used, and the corresponding legal basis under the GDPR.

Purpose of Processing: To provide my services, fulfil your orders, manage your account, and for customer service.

Categories of Data Used: Identity, Contact, Transaction

Legal Basis for Processing: Necessary for the performance of a contract with you.

Purpose of Processing: To manage my relationship with you, including responding to your inquiries and requests.

Categories of Data Used: Identity, Contact, Communication

Legal Basis for Processing: My legitimate interest in providing good customer service and communicating with you.

Purpose of Processing: To send you marketing communications about my services, offers, and news (only where you have explicitly agreed).

Categories of Data Used: Identity, Contact

Legal Basis for Processing: Your consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting me or using the unsubscribe link in any marketing email.

Purpose of Processing: To comply with my legal and regulatory obligations, particularly French accounting and tax laws applicable to *autoentrepreneurs*.

Categories of Data Used: Identity, Contact, Transaction

Legal Basis for Processing: Necessary for compliance with a legal obligation.

4. Data Retention

I will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this policy, or to comply with my legal obligations.

* Customer and Transaction Data: I retain this data for a period of 10 years from the end of the financial year in which the transaction occurred, in accordance with French accounting and tax law requirements for *autoentrepreneurs*.

* Marketing Contact Data: I retain this data for 3 years from your last interaction with my communications (e.g., opening an email) or until you withdraw your consent.

* Inquiry Data: If you contact me but do not become a customer, I retain your communication data for 2 years for administrative and service quality purposes.

At the end of the applicable retention period, your data will be securely deleted or anonymised.

5. Your Rights Under the GDPR

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- * Right of Access: To request a copy of your data.
- * Right to Rectification: To correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- * Right to Erasure ("Right to be Forgotten"): To request deletion of your data, subject to certain conditions.
- * Right to Restriction of Processing: To request that I temporarily suspend processing your data.
- * Right to Data Portability: To receive your data in a structured, commonly used format.
- * Right to Object: To object to processing based on my legitimate interests.
- * Right to Withdraw Consent: To withdraw your consent for marketing at any time.

6. Data Sharing and International Transfers

- * I do not sell, trade, or rent your personal data to third parties.
- * I may share your data with trusted service providers who act on my instructions ("data processors"), such as:
 - * Payment processing services.
 - * Email communication platforms.
 - * Website hosting and IT service providers.
- * International Transfers: Some of these service providers may be located outside the European Economic Area (EEA), including in the United Kingdom. I ensure any such transfer is governed by appropriate safeguards as required by the GDPR, such as the European Commission's adequacy decision regarding the UK, or Standard Contractual Clauses.

I require all third parties to respect the security of your personal data and to treat it in accordance with the law.

7. Data Security

I have implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data from accidental loss, unauthorised access, alteration, or disclosure. While I strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your data, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is 100% secure.

8. Cookies and Analytics

My website does not use cookies or tracking technologies to collect personal data about individual visitors. My website hosting provider may collect anonymised, aggregated technical data (such as page views, general geographic regions, and referral sources) for server performance and security purposes. This data is collected server-side and does not identify you personally, track your browsing behaviour, or require your consent under GDPR.
